The principal purpose of the Alabama Correctional Employee Support Fund, Inc. is to provide financial support and assistance to persons employed by the Alabama Department of Corrections and members of such persons' families who are needy, ill or distressed because of disaster, hardship, or other circumstances.

The ACESF also provides educational scholarship opportunities to persons employed by the ADOC and members of such persons' families based on need and/or merit.

The ACESF conducts fund raising events to support the Corporation's principal purposes. The events include golf tournaments in Montgomery, Huntsville, Decatur, and Atmore. Proceeds from the Huntsville tournament directly support an annual scholarship in memory of Charles and Doris Farquhar. Individual correctional facilities also host events such as Boston Butt sales, fish fries, dove hunts, luncheons; and sales of ADOC promotional items, apparel, and handcrafted wooden footballs. The ACESF has also recently been approved to accept donations through State's United Way Combined Campaign. Since 2004, the ACESF has given almost \$300,000 back to employees in need.

All proceeds will support ADOC employees through an application and needs validation process to be approved by a committee of the ACESF. We wish to extend our heartfelt thanks for your support and participation.
